BYLAW NO. 1391

A BYLAW TO AMEND THE STREETS AND TRAFFIC REGULATION BYLAW

The Municipal Council of the District of North Saanich, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

TEXT AMENDMENTS

1. Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw No. 1261, 2012 is hereby amended as follows:

(a) Section 1.5 Definitions is amended by adding:

“landscaped boulevard” means a regularly maintained boulevard with or without a curb that has been improved by grading and levelling, the placement of topsoil or other soil amendment, and the planting of trees or shrubs, the placing of sod, or the seeding of grass or other perennial vegetation, and does not include a boulevard on which only natural vegetation is growing, whether or not that vegetation is being or has been trimmed or otherwise managed by the District.

(b) Part 4 Parking Regulations is amended in Section 4.1 (a) by changing “boulevard” to “landscaped boulevard”.
