#### Mayor and Council

I have reviewed the Staff Report on the agenda for Monday's meeting recommending the purchase of a new dump truck. Upon reading this, and applying a climate change lens, I immediately wondered if there was an option to purchase an electric or hybrid option. The little bit of research I did indicated they are a few years away and I suspect this was already considered by staff in making their recommendation.

While researching the vehicles I discovered the City of Vancouver is now using 100% renewable diesel in their fleet <a href="https://vancouver.ca/green-vancouver/green-fleets.aspx">https://vancouver.ca/green-vancouver/green-fleets.aspx</a>. E3 Fleet provides some excellent information about the switch to biodiesel / renewable diesel <a href="https://www.e3fleet.com/biodiesel.html">https://www.e3fleet.com/biodiesel.html</a> and the BC Sustainable Energy Association provides some good background information on biodiesel and renewable diesel fuels <a href="https://www.bcsea.org/biodiesel-0">https://www.bcsea.org/biodiesel-0</a>. I wonder if this is something the District of North Saanich could consider? I expect this would contribute both to a decrease in CO2 emissions and in particulate matter in the municipal operations.
