TITLE: COMMISSIONS/COMMUNICATIONS	NO. COU-010	

A direct line of communication between the Advisory Planning (APC), Agricultural Advisory (AAC), Environmental Advisory (EAC), Parks (PAC) and Heritage (HAC) Commissions and the Director of Infrastructure Services/Approving Officer and Director of Development and Community Services is approved. (20/85 - revised)

The agendas for the Advisory Planning, Agricultural Advisory, Environmental Advisory, Parks and Heritage Commissions, shall be posted at the Municipal Hall for the information of the Public. (241/92, 04/05/92, 615/92 – revised)

If the Commissions wish to consider a specific subject which has not yet been referred, the council liaison should advise the Council of the Commission's interest in the matter, and it is then the decision of the Council whether or not to officially refer the matter. (320/84)

The Chairs of the APC and the EAC should be in touch with one another on a regular basis and the minutes of the meetings of each Commission be exchanged and received by the Chairs. (881/83)

The EAC and PAC are to be provided with any correspondence from Transport Canada the Airport Manager and the Ministry of Fisheries and Oceans with respect to Reay Creek. (622/95)

Where development permits are issued as a result of deliberations by the EAC, the Commission is to be given the opportunity to review the manner in which the permit criteria have been executed. 306/91)
