TITLE: PARKS AND RECREATIONAL TRAILS INSPECTION	NO. COU-085
AND MAINTENANCE POLICY	

POLICY INTENT

The purpose of this policy is to establish a system of inspections and maintenance for parks and multiuse trails located within the District of North Saanich that is reasonable and balances protection from the risks associated with defects in parks and multi-use trails with the other priorities of the District of North Saanich.

The system of inspections and maintenance established by this policy is reasonable in all of the circumstances given the allocation of budgetary resources and the availability of District of North Saanich personnel and equipment.

DEFINITIONS

The following definitions apply for the purposes of this policy:

Developed Parks: Recreational area designed, operated and maintained by the District's Parks

Department that typically includes features such as paths, playgrounds, sports

fields and courts, restrooms, benches, tables, dog parks.

Maintained Trails: Those trails which are maintained by the District's Parks Department and are also

defined as Multi-Use trails.

Medium priority: Response to a failure that would not affect services. Response time is within

three business days of receiving notification, personnel will attend the site to review the issue, and the repair/service/remedy will be scheduled within one

month.

Low priority: Response to non-critical failures, repairs, service and installation of items. Response time is within five business days of receiving notification, personnel will attend the site to review the issue and the repair/service/remedy will be scheduled within four months.
