In order to establish truck routes within the District, the road must be identified by by-law so that						
the routes are enforceable by the R.C.M.P. Once a by-law is prepared for banning trucks from one route, there may be continuous requests and pressure to add and subtract truck routes. Routes						
would also have to be signed. Service and delivery vehicles normally continue utilizing the roads.						
Policy						
It is recommended that when a complaint is received, the District contact the trucking firm involved and ask that trucks not use residential streets.
