COUNCIL POLICY

TITLE: DIRECTIONAL SIGNS FOR TOURIST SERVICES, FACILITIES AND ATTRACTIONS NO. COU-113

- 1. The following will apply to confirmatory directional signs on North Saanich Roads which are installed in accordance with Council's policy adopted May 3, 2010:
 - a) The District of North Saanich will allow confirmatory signs on municipal roads subject to the facility being approved under the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure Policy for Supplemental signs;
 - b) The signage shall conform to the catalogue of supplemental signs as provided by the British Columbia Provincial Sign Program;
 - c) These signs shall be provided by the applicant and installed by the District;
 - d) The permits for signs shall be for a 3 year term;
 - e) The installation charge per sign shall be \$125.00 paid in advance of installation;
 - f) An annual maintenance fee of \$25.00 shall be paid in advance for 3 years;
 - g) The applicant may request wording and number of locations for the signs but the District will determine the suitability of the requested wording and will determine the actual location and number of the signs;
 - h) Sign size will follow the dimensions for applications typical to local roads;
 - i) Applications for signs shall be in writing, clearly detailing requested wording and preferred locations.
