

Introduction

The purpose of this guide is to function as a list of suggestions for applicants considering the development of land in North Saanich. As part of a larger regional community, the District of North Saanich plays a specific role which is different from other member municipalities in the Capital Regional District.

Our rural and agricultural values and our distance from the growth and service centres in the region means that North Saanich's role in a sustainable region provides limited opportunity for housing diversity and increasing densities. Instead, sustainability goals in North Saanich will concentrate on protecting the rural and agricultural nature of the community, clustering allowable development to reduce impacts and costs of maintaining services, encouraging the limited development to be as sustainable as possible through green building design and to ensure that environmental values are maintained and, where possible, enhanced.

We ask that all applicants use this guide in preparing your rezoning proposal as it will be reviewed and assessed by municipal staff, Commissions and Council in considering your proposal. Please ensure you provide rationale to explain your assessment for review by the District. You can download a digital copy of the Guide to allow you to have sufficient room to input supporting rationale.

Definitions:

"Visitable' means a home that is designed to be at least partly accessible to people with mobility impairments by including three key features:

- 1. At least one zero-step entrance on an accessible route leading from a driveway or public sidewalk;
- 2. All interior doors providing at least 31 ¾ inches (81 cm) of unobstructed passage space; and
- 3. At least a half bathroom on the main floor.

[&]quot;Xeriscape" refers to environmentally friendly forms of landscaping incorporates locallyadapted and drought-tolerant plants, shrubs, and ground cover and minimizes the use of irrigation.
